PROJECT370 NOT PARTY TO ANY LITIGATION IN REGARD TO FLIGHT MH370

Approaches have been made to the Project370 media office for comment on breaking news reports regarding litigation as between certain next of kin representatives and an aircraft manufacturer.

In this regard Project370 places on record that is an independent, worldwide, volunteer run organisation focused solely on completing the search for the hull of Boeing 777, 9M-MRO, the airliner that operated flight MH370.

The project company and its officers are not affiliated with any of the parties involved in any litigation in regard to the flight.

Project370, its officers and volunteers are therefore not in any position to comment in regard to suits flowing from flight MH370 which may currently be, or which may come, before courts anywhere in the world.

Project370 is a formal non-profit. It was established using internet co-operation and meeting technologies following the announcement of the cessation of official searches for flight MH370.

Project370 is collating all available data on possible locations of 9M-MRO and – donations permitting - will commission sea surveys on a priority basis to scan identified areas until, it is hoped, the location of the aircraft can be determined.

All costs of running and establishing the entity thus far have been, and will be, absorbed by its volunteers.

Upon a successful conclusion of the project, the entity's founding documents and constitution provide for the donation of any surplus donations in its accounts to ICAO for the improvement of over-water tracking technology used on the world's civil aviation fleet.

Project370 is appealing to the world's public to assist the volunteers by offering donations towards the costs of the proposed sea surveys to locate the missing airliner.
