Project370 is collating all available data on possible locations of 9M-MRO and – funds permitting - will commission sea surveys on a priority basis to scan identified areas until, it is hoped, the location of the aircraft can be determined.

All costs of running and establishing the entity thus far have been, and will be, absorbed by its volunteers. Upon a successful conclusion of the project, the entity's founding documents and constitution provide for the donation of any surplus funds in its accounts to entities working towards the improvement of over-water tracking technology used on the world's civil aviation fleet.
